- HOA Board Annual Election: All homeowners should be receiving a letter or email from BCM Services Inc that will announce which HOA board members are up for reelection and gives any homeowner the opportunity to run for election for the HOA board. <u>Remember, a HOA Quorum of 122 homeowner</u> "votes" is required for the annual HOA board election to be valid and to be counted, resulting either in a current HOA board member being reelected or a new homeowner elected to replace the former HOA board member. If a HOA Quorum is not met, then the existing HOA board members remain as is. - The Jacksonville Fire Rescue Dept (JFRD) Fire Marshal completed an Annual Fire Inspection at the Amenity Center and noted the Fire Extinguishers met safety code but the Emergency Light Exit signs and backup batteries were old and did not work. An Electrician was hired by the HOA to replace the Emergency EXIT signs with backup batteries in September 2024. Since 2019, I, (Editor) have repeatedly requested the HOA board ask JFRD to conduct an Annual Fire Inspection but nothing happened. HAZMAT items and gasoline (with vapors) were stored in the "Electrical room (an ignition source)" for years. Last October, our HOA President, Christina Bennett asked for volunteers to cleanup the Amenity Center with its numerous closets/ rooms, resulting in the organization of items, removal of trash and broken decorations and HAZMAT items. I submitted a Service Request to COJ MyJax in August 2024 & JFRD completed the Fire inspection in September 2024. I talked to JFRD Captain Barrett about this. This is a recurring inspection.
- NOTE: <u>WE celebrate the portion of Pecan Park Road in front of our community entrance has been repaved including our 135' Service Entrance</u>...removing the numerous Pot Holes we avoided when entering Lexington Park. Thanks to the COJ road crew who worked Friday, Saturday & Monday in SEPT and thanks to our HOA President Christina Bennett and other homeowners for your persistence in completing this project.
